AMBER Alert

CONFIRMED/WITNESSED ABDUCTION

1. Victim under 18 years of age,
2. Confirmed abduction by Law Enforcement **and** victim is in danger of serious bodily harm or death,
3. There is enough descriptive information concerning the circumstances, suspect, vehicle, and victim that activation of the alert will help locate the child,
4. Not a family dispute or custody issue, *unless #2, above, applies.*

Missing Child Alert

UNKNOWN CIRCUMSTANCES

1. Victim under 18 years of age,
2. Missing Child:
 - ♦ Lost,
 - ♦ Non-Witnessed/Non-Confirmed Abduction,
 - ♦ Child's whereabouts are unknown.
